Please read our house rules so everyone can enjoy their visit safely.

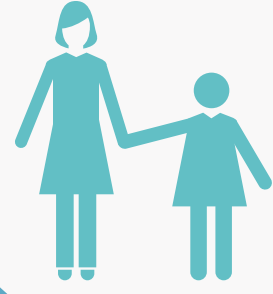

No swimming certificate

Children without a swimming certificate must always wear swimming armbands and stay within arm's reach of an accompanying adult aged 18 or over.

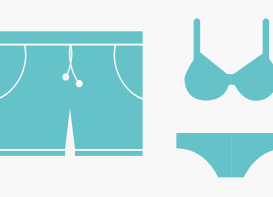
This adult must be a **competent swimmer**.

Swimwear required

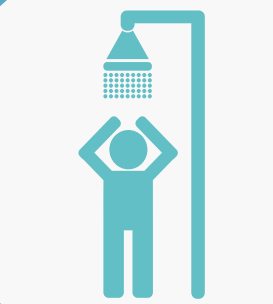
Appropriate swimwear must be worn in all pools.

Shower before swimming

Shower before entering the pool. This helps keep the water clean.

Walk carefully

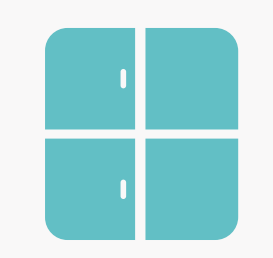
Walk carefully in and around the pools. Floors may be slippery.

Use a locker

Store clothing and valuables safely in a locker. Use of lockers is at your own risk.

No shoes

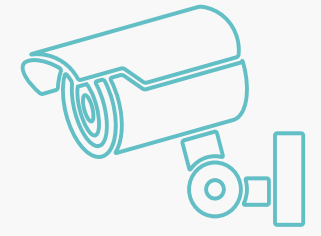
Shoes are not permitted in the pool hall or in wet areas, including changing rooms.

Security Cameras

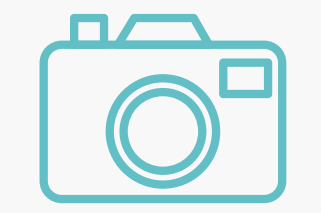
Security cameras are in operation throughout the facility for the safety of our visitors and staff.

Respect each other's privacy

Only photograph or film yourself or members of your own group.

Keep it clean

Please leave the pool area tidy and dispose of your rubbish in the designated bins.

No glass

Glass items are not permitted in or around the swimming pools, on the terraces or on the sunbathing lawn.

No alcohol or drugs

Alcohol and drugs are not permitted anywhere in our swimming pool.

Smoking and vaping (including e-cigarettes)

are therefore not permitted inside the building, on the sunbathing lawn, around the buildings (including the entrance) or in the car park.
